

ECLIC Participation model & fees

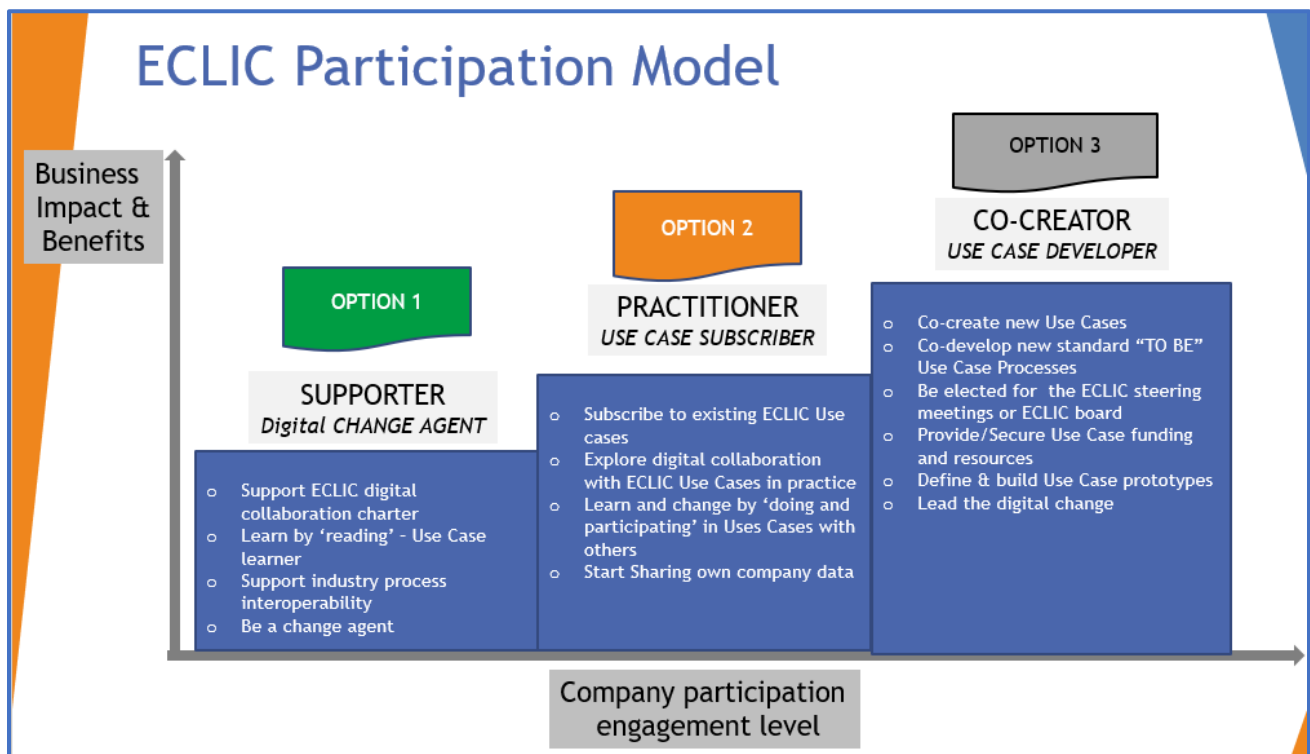


Figure 1: ECLIC participating model and options to join the ECLIC community

In support of the **ECLIC digital collaboration charter** and Cefic digital collaboration position paper (separate document), individual chemical companies and Logistics Service Providers can voluntarily join and engage with the ECLIC business network and actively participate with the ECLIC community via the ECLIC participation model (figure 1).



The role of ECLIC is to facilitate, define and build interoperable digital industry solutions within Chemical Logistics and offering an “open source” best practice digital collaboration toolbox while fulfilling the requirements as described in the Cefic digital collaboration position paper (respect for data, trust, ...). A first ECLIC Use Case is the electronic EFTCO Cleaning Document (or eECD) whereby all actors contribute to a uniform, more transparent, compliant and sustainable cleaning process reducing the risks of cross-contaminations, paper-fraud and human errors.

A company that want to participate within the ECLIC community, has the option to join as an ECLIC SUPPORTER, PRACTITIONER or CO-CREATOR and this depending on the individual company interest and engagement level.

The fees related to the ECLIC participation model are explained in appendix 1 per level and depend on the company size and turnover. These fees have been approved by the ECLIC board while maintaining open book financial principles and aiming for zero profit.

Appendix 1: ECLIC participation model - fee structure

The LEVEL 1 SUPPORTER participation level brings the following benefits:

- Once an annual ECLIC participation fee is paid, a company is entitled to obtain free access to the tools & documentation present in the unified, interoperable eECD digital collaboration toolbox. The IT platform itself is powered by NxtPort who offers the IT platform services. This level of participation allows a company to run virtual eECD-ePPL test scenario's with own products. (unified industry eECD test platform).
- A typical participant gets access via an own eECD company admin LOGIN ID and password and obtains access to the latest eECD-ePPL process documentation. This way it can "read, watch, assess and learn" how the unified interoperable industry solution looks like and can prepare for an eECD-ePPL implementation at its own pace. Besides, it allows to make an internal eECD-ePPL project assessment while creating a digital collaborative mindset.

LEVEL 2 PRACTITIONER

The LEVEL 2 PRACTITIONER participation fees are based on the existing eECD Use Case and the (public) eECD tariff table can be consulted on the ECLIC website: www.ecllic.eu. On this website you also find the eECD Use Case Order subscription Form for those companies who want to subscribe to eECD-ePPL Use Case and start using it in practice together with more than 50 other companies.

- As ECLIC PRACTITIONER your company can register with the NxtPort platform for an active eECD-EPPL licence and obtains a Login ID and password to further explore the existing eECD-ePPL digital collaboration Use Case functionalities in practice together with other subscribed suppliers. The latest list of subscribed companies can be consulted on the ECLIC website.

- Companies already subscribed to the ECLIC eECD Use Case (=level 2) are automatically registered as ECLIC company network participant (Level 1 SUPPORTER)

LEVEL 3 CO-CREATOR

The LEVEL 3 CO-CREATOR Participation are defined per ECLIC Use Case and depend on the ECLIC use Case roadmap and industry priorities in 2022 and beyond. Planned Use Case are eCMR, ePLR (= forbidden preloads) , ETA, equipment pre-notifications, etc

A minimum Level 2 participation is required, before companies can join the co-creation level 3. Reason is that the co-creation Level 3 builds further on established data, functionalities and interfaces used in the existing level 2.

ePLR = Electronic Previous Load Restrictions
eCMR= electronic version of the freight document
ETA = expected time of arrival
