



ECLIC PRIVACY STATEMENT

SCOPE

The European Chemical Logistics Information Council (hereinafter ECLIC) aims to facilitate secured data sharing among participants of industries related to chemical logistics through a data sharing application platform allowing to transform the current manual and paper driven logistics processes into more integrated, collaborative, electronic and real time processes of data sharing.

In the context of its activities, ECLIC may collect, store or otherwise process personal data. Based on applicable data protection and privacy law and, in particular, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), ECLIC qualifies as the data controller with respect to the processing of your personal data. This privacy statement will explain how ECLIC uses the personal data we collect from you when you visit the ECLIC website.

By using the ECLIC services and/or the ECLIC website and by providing your personal data to us, you acknowledge that your personal data will be processed in accordance with this privacy statement.. ECLIC reserves the right to modify unilaterally and at any time these Terms and Conditions

1. Purposes of data processing

This is the privacy statement of ECLIC, the European Chemical Logistics Information Council. ECLIC is an non-profit association with its head office in Boulevard Auguste Reyers 80, 1030 Brussels-Belgium and aims to facilitate secured data sharing among participants of industries related to chemical logistics through a data sharing application platform allowing to transform the current manual and paper driven logistics processes into more integrated, collaborative, electronic and real time processes of data sharing.

a) Participation

ECLIC will hold and process personal data in the context of the “participation” to ECLIC for the following purposes:

- Submit an inquiry through our website.
- Register online to receive news updates or newsletters from ECLIC

- Voluntarily complete a survey or request for feedback through our website or by email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.
- Voluntarily share your personal data with us, for example if you communicate with us via email or by other means, or if you are active as a subject matter expert.
- Managing your company and user profile info
- Managing access to our ECLIC website and participant services
- Sending you information we believe may be of interest to you based on your company profile or the interests you have communicated to us
- Seeking information about you and your company for the submitted requests
- The lawful basis for processing your data is within the legitimate interests of ECLIC and in line with our non-profit mission.

b) Project implementation

ECLIC will hold and process data of representatives of Participants of ECLIC and of persons involved in other Use Case projects in order to achieve the shared objectives of the projects and the ECLIC mission. ECLIC will also hold and process data of persons who apply to take part in ECLIC activities and/or workshop meetings. In all cases, we believe that there is a contractual basis for processing such personal data.

c) General purposes

ECLIC will hold and process personal data of ECLIC Participants for the following purpose:

- providing information which we reasonably believe is relevant to your personal or company goals
- managing your participation in an ECLIC Use Case, ECLIC event, or any other ECLIC activity
- managing your partnership with ECLIC in a joint project or project Use Case application In the case of general purposes, the lawful basis for processing your data is in the legitimate interests and in line with ECLIC's non-profit mission.
- Verifying if you and your company are an active member of one of the ECLIC founding associations, ECTA, essencia-Cefic or EFTCO.

2. Personal data

The personal data which ECLIC holds and processes may cover:



- Name, job title, professional experiences and company name, address & invoicing details
- Contact information including email address, phone numbers
- Specific Use Case licence and Payment information you have provided in the context of a specific ECLIC Use Case subscription
- Banking details you have provided where you are entitled to payment for participation in an ECLIC Use Case or activity

3. Third party providers

ECLIC uses third party providers to deliver the ECLIC Participants benefits and manage your data on a confidential basis. In order to deliver its services, ECLIC acts in partnership with project partners. Those project partners may have access to your data in the context of enabling your participation in Use Case or project activity not directly managed by ECLIC. ECLIC will not share your data with other third parties without your permission and ECLIC will never sell your personal data with a commercial purpose.

The ECLIC website contains links to other websites. This ECLIC privacy statement applies only to the ECLIC website, so if you click on a link to another website, you should read their privacy statement.

The ECLIC website is using WordPress.com as website tool. WordPress is a platform provided by Automattic A8C Ireland Ltd. that allows the Owner to build, run and host this ECLIC website.

4. Where your data is stored

All contact information that we collect from you is stored in a participant database which is hosted in Europe and the hosts are committed to GDPR compliance. By submitting your personal data and or accepting the ECLIC terms and conditions, you agree to this transfer, storing and/or processing of your personal and company data.

5. Data sources

The data we hold may come from one of the followings: your subscription to our ECLIC newsletter; a personal email exchange towards ECLIC for more info, your personal ECLIC company pre-registration application; data publicly available online; business cards; your registration for an ECLIC Use Case or working group.



6. ECLIC website and cookies

Our ECLIC website uses cookies to collect anonymous information about the ECLIC web pages you visit, the software tools you use and your IP address & location. These statistical data about the user browsing actions and patterns help us to improve the ECLIC website content, do not identify any individual and are not used for advertisement or any other commercial purposes.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, however, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.

7. Controlling your personal information
